

ZNF75 (W-16): sc-102268



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc finger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. Zinc finger protein 75 (ZNF75), also known as ZNF82, is a 289 amino acid member of the Krüppel C₂H₂-type zinc finger protein family. Localized to the nucleus, ZNF75 contains five C₂H₂-type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain through which it is thought to be involved in DNA-binding and transcriptional regulation.

SOURCE

ZNF75 (W-16) is a purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against ZNF75 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 100 µg IgG in 1.0 ml PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide, 0.1% gelatin and < 0.02% sucrose.

APPLICATIONS

ZNF75 (W-16) is recommended for detection of ZNF75 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500), immunohistochemistry (including paraffin-embedded sections) (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF75 siRNA (h): sc-90999, ZNF75 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-90999-SH and ZNF75 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-90999-V.

Molecular Weight of ZNF75: 34 kDa.

RECOMMENDED SECONDARY REAGENTS
