The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

The phosphorylation and dephosphorylation of proteins on serine and threonine residues is an essential means of regulating a broad range of cellular functions in eukaryotes, including cell division, homeostasis and apoptosis. A group of proteins that are intimately involved in this process are the serine/threonine (Ser/Thr) protein kinases. DCAMKL3 (Doublecortin-like and CAM kinase-like 3), also known as DCLK3 or DCDC3C, is a 648 amino acid protein that localizes to both the nucleus and the cytoplasm and contains one protein kinase domain. One of several members of the Ser/Thr protein kinase family, DCAMKL3 functions to catalyze the ATP-dependent attachment of a phospho residue to target proteins, an event that may play a role in various cellular processes.

Genetic locus: DCLK3 (human) mapping to 3p22.2.

SOURCE

DCAMKL3 (C-14) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping at the C-terminus of DCAMKL3 of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

RESEARCH USE

For research use only, not for use in diagnostic procedures.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 100 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-102472 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

DCAMKL3 (C-14) is recommended for detection of DCAMKL3 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μ g per 100-500 μ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with family members DCAMKL1 or DCAMKL2.

Suitable for use as control antibody for DCAMKL3 siRNA (h): sc-78120, DCAMKL3 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-78120-SH and DCAMKL3 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-78120-V.


