The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Acetycholine (Ach) is a neurotransmitter present in both the peripheral nervous system (PNS) and the central nervous system (CNS) that is important for the transmission of nerve impulses. In the PNS, acetylcholine plays a role in skeletal muscle movement and the regulation of smooth muscle and cardiac muscle, while in the CNS, acetylcholine is thought to be involved in mood, learning and memory. AchBP (acetylcholine-binding protein), is a 229 amino acid protein which modulates neuronal synaptic transmission by binding to acetylcholine. Containing one Ig-like domain, AChBP is expressed in glial cells and is secreted into the synaptic cleft. AChBP is N-glycosylated and forms a homopentamer.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-103952 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

AChBP (G-14) is recommended for detection of AChBP of *Lymnaea stagnalis* origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Molecular Weight of AChBP: 26 kDa.
