The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

COMMD family members are a group of evolutionary conserved proteins that share a common COMM domain at the extreme C-terminus, which provides an interface for protein-protein interactions. Of the ten family members, the role of COMMD1, also known as MURR1, is best characterized, functioning to inhibit TNF-induced NF κ B p50 and to facilitate biliary copper excretion within hepatocytes. Most, if not all, COMMD proteins have been found to play a role in the regulation NF κ B and, despite their similarities, seem to function in unique and non-redundant pathways. COMMD proteins may also play a role in the function of epithelial sodium channels, cell proliferation, copper homeostasis and in the regulation of the ubiquitin pathway. COMM domain-containing protein 8 is a 183 amino acid protein that is widely expressed with highest expression in thyroid.

COMMD8 (Y-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of COMMD8 of mouse origin.

APPLICATIONS

COMMD8 (Y-15) is recommended for detection of COMMD8 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 µg per 100-500 µg of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other COMMD family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for COMMD8 siRNA (m): sc-105231, COMMD8 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-105231-SH and COMMD8 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-105231-V.


