The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Mitochondrial ribosomes consist of a large 39S subunit and a small 28S subunit, both of which are comprised of multiple mitochondrial ribosomal proteins (MRPs) that are encoded by nuclear genes and are essential for protein synthesis within mitochondria. MRP-L55 (mitochondrial ribosomal protein L55), is a 128 amino acid protein that localizes to the mitochondrion, where it exists as a component of the 39S ribosomal subunit and works in conjunction with other MRPs to mediate protein synthesis. In *Drosophila melanogaster*, MRP-L55 expression is critical for development and is involved in mitochondrial biogenesis and G_2/M phase cell cycle progression. The gene encoding MRP-L55 maps to human chromosome 1, which spans about 260 million base pairs and comprises nearly 8% of the human genome. There are two isoforms of MRP-L55 that are produced as a result of alternative splicing events.

Genetic locus: MRPL55 (human) mapping to 1q42.13.

MRP-L55 (S-14) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of MRP-L55 of human origin.

PRODUCT

APPLICATIONS

MRP-L55 (S-14) is recommended for detection of MRP-L55 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for MRP-L55 siRNA (h): sc-88244, MRP-L55 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-88244-SH and MRP-L55 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-88244-V.

Molecular Weight of MRP-L55: 15 kDa.
