The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Olfactory receptors are G protein-coupled receptors that localize to the cilia of olfactory sensory neurons where they display affinity for and bind to a variety of odor molecules. The genes encoding olfactory receptors comprise the largest family in the human genome. The binding of olfactory receptor proteins to odor molecules triggers a signal transduction that propagates nerve impulses throughout the body, ultimately leading to transmission of the signal to the brain and the subsequent perception of smell. OR2A5 (olfactory receptor 2A5) is a 311 amino acid protein, OR2A14 (olfactory receptor 2A14) is a 310 amino acid protein and OR2A42 (olfactory receptor 2A42) is a 304 amino acid protein. The genes encoding OR2A5, OR2A14 and OR2A42 map to human chromosome 7q35.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: OR2A42/OR2A14/OR2A5 (human) mapping to 7q35.

SOURCE

OR2A5/14/42 (A-12) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an extracellular domain of OR2A14 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-109623 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

APPLICATIONS

OR2A5/14/42 (A-12) is recommended for detection of OR2A5, OR2A14 and OR2A42 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

OR2A1/5/14/42 (A-12) is also recommended for detection of OR2A1, OR2A5, OR2A14 and OR2A42 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Molecular Weight of OR2A5: 35 kDa.
