# C20orf141 (T-21): sc-130994

# BACKGROUND

The gene encoding C20orf141 maps to human chromosome 20, which houses over 600 genes, some of which are associated with Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, spinal muscular atrophy, ring chromosome 20 epilepsy syndrome and Alagille syndrome. Additionally, chromosome 20 contains a region with numerous genes which are thought important for seminal production and may be potential targets for male contraception. The PRNP gene encoding the prion protein associated with spongiform encephalopathies, like Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, is found on chromosome 20. The C20orf141 gene product has been provisionally designated C20orf141 pending further characterization.

# SOURCE

C20orf141 (T-21) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic C20orf141 peptide of human origin.

#### PRODUCT

Each vial contains 50  $\mu g$  IgG in 500  $\mu I$  PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide, 0.1% gelatin and < 0.02% sucrose.

#### **APPLICATIONS**

C20orf141 (T-21) is recommended for detection of C20orf141 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2  $\mu$ g per 100-500  $\mu$ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)] and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for C20orf141 siRNA (h): sc-72708, C20orf141 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-72708-SH and C20orf141 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-72708-V.

Molecular Weight of C20orf141: 17 kDa.

Positive Controls: MCF7 whole cell lysate: sc-2206.

#### **RECOMMENDED SECONDARY REAGENTS**

To ensure optimal results, the following support (secondary) reagents are recommended: 1) Western Blotting: use goat anti-rabbit IgG-HRP: sc-2004 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:100,000) or Cruz Marker™ compatible goat anti-rabbit IgG-HRP: sc-2030 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:5000), Cruz Marker™ Molecular Weight Standards: sc-2035, TBS Blotto A Blocking Reagent: sc-2333 and Western Blotting Luminol Reagent: sc-2048. 2) Immunoprecipitation: use Protein A/G PLUS-Agarose: sc-2003 (0.5 ml agarose/2.0 ml).
