The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Olfactory receptors interact with odorant molecules in the nose to initiate a neuronal response that leads to the perception of smell. While they share a seven transmembrane domain structure with many neurotransmitter and hormone receptors, olfactory receptors are responsible for the recognition and transduction of odorant signals. The olfactory receptor gene family is the largest in the genome. OR1M1 (olfactory receptor 1M1), also known as OR19-5 or OR19-6, is a 313 amino acid multi-pass membrane protein that belongs to the G-protein coupled receptor 1 family. The gene that encodes OR1M1 consists of nearly 1,000 bases and maps to human chromosome 19p13.2. Chromosome 19 consists of over 63 million bases, houses approximately 1,400 genes and is recognized for having the greatest gene density of the human chromosomes. It is the genetic home for a number of immunoglobulin (Ig) superfamily members, including the killer cell and leukocyte Ig-like receptors, a number of ICAMs, the CEACAM and PSG families and Fc receptors (FcRs).

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: OR1M1 (human) mapping to 19p13.2.

SOURCE

OR1M1 (S-12) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an extracellular domain of OR1M1 of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-131222 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

OR1M1 (S-12) is recommended for detection of OR1M1 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other OR family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for OR1M1 siRNA (h): sc-97898, OR1M1 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-97898-SH and OR1M1 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-97898-V.

Molecular Weight of OR1M1: 35 kDa.
