# ZNF683 (N-13): sc-131857



The Power to Question

## **BACKGROUND**

Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc-finger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. Zinc finger protein 683 (ZNF683) is a 509 amino acid member of the Krüppel  $\rm C_2H_2$ -type zinc-finger protein family. Localized to the nucleus, ZNF683 contains four  $\rm C_2H_2$ -type zinc fingers through which it is thought to be involved in DNA-binding and transcriptional regulation. Two isoforms of ZNF683 exist as a result of alternative splicing events.

ZNF683 (N-13) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the N-terminus of ZNF683 of human origin.

## **APPLICATIONS**

ZNF683 (N-13) is recommended for detection of ZNF683 isoforms 1 and 2 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ZNF family members .

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF683 siRNA (h): sc-88560, ZNF683 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-88560-SH and ZNF683 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-88560-V.
