# ZNF398 (P-15): sc-132178



BACKGROUND

Zinc finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc finger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. Zinc finger protein 398 (ZNF398), also known as zinc finger DNA-binding protein p52/p71 or ZER6, is a 642 amino acid member of the Krüppel  $C_2H_2$ -type zinc finger protein family. Localized to the nucleus, ZNF627 contains nine  $C_2H_2$ -type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain through which it is thought to be involved in DNA-binding and transcriptional regulation. Existing as two isoforms produced by alternative splicing, ZNF398 is induced by ER $\alpha$ .

### SOURCE

ZNF398 (P-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF398 of human origin.

## PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-132178 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

## **STORAGE**

Store at 4° C, \*\*D0 NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

## APPLICATIONS

ZNF398 (P-15) is recommended for detection of ZNF398 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 µg per 100-500 µg of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ZNF family members.

ZNF398 (P-15) is also recommended for detection of ZNF398 in additional species, including canine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF398 siRNA (h): sc-89890, ZNF398 siRNA (m): sc-155709, ZNF398 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-89890-SH, ZNF398 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-155709-SH, ZNF398 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-89890-V and ZNF398 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-155709-V.

ZNF398 (P-15) X TransCruz antibody is recommended for Gel Supershift and ChIP applications.

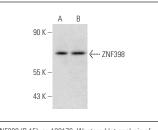
