The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc-finger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. Zinc finger protein 92 (ZNF92) is a 586 amino acid member of the Krüppel C_2H_2 -type zinc-finger protein family. Localized to the nucleus, ZNF92 contains 16 C_2H_2 -type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain through which it is thought to be involved in DNA-binding and transcriptional regulation. Three isoforms of ZNF92 exist as a result of alternative splicing events.

Genetic locus: ZNF92 (human) mapping to 7q11.21.

ZNF92 (K-12) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF92 of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-132603 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

ZNF92 (K-12) is recommended for detection of ZNF92 isoforms 1-3 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μg per 100-500 μg of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ZNF family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF92 siRNA (h): sc-89380, ZNF92 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-89380-SH and ZNF92 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-89380-V.


