# ALKBH8 (G-13): sc-132617



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

ALKBH8 (alkylated DNA repair protein AlkB homolog 8) is a 664 amino acid protein that is encoded by a gene located on chromosome 11. ALKBH8 contains one RRM (RNA recognition motif) domain and belongs to the AlkB family of proteins. ALKBH8 is one of many homologs of the *Escherichia coli* protein AlkB. AlkB functions to protect DNA and RNA against damage from environmental methylating compounds by directly reversing 1-methyladenine (1-meA) and 3-methylcytosine (3-meC) cytotoxic alkylation lesions in DNA and RNA. The enzyme acts by oxidative demethylation, utilizing ferrous iron and  $\alpha$ -ketoglutarate as cofactors, 2-oxoglutarate as a co-substrate and molecular oxygen as the oxidizing agent. Three isoforms exist for ALKBH8 due to alternative splicing of the gene.

### **APPLICATIONS**

ALKBH8 (G-13) is recommended for detection of ALKBH8 isoforms 1-3 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2  $\mu$ g per 100-500  $\mu$ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ALKBH family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ALKBH8 siRNA (m): sc-141025, ALKBH8 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-141025-SH and ALKBH8 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-141025-V.


