The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc finger protein 223 (ZNF223) is a 482 amino acid member of the Krüppel C_2H_2 -type zinc-finger protein family. Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zincfinger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. ZNF223 localizes to the nucleus and contains ten C_2H_2 type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain through which it is thought to be involved in DNA-binding and transcriptional regulation. ZNF222 and ZNF223 are both found on chromosome 19 at location 19q13.31 likely making these paralogous gene products.

Genetic locus: ZNF222 (human) mapping to 19q13.31; ZNF223 (human) mapping to 19q13.31.

SOURCE

ZNF222/223 (E-13) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF223 of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-132917 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

ZNF222/223 (E-13) is recommended for detection of ZNF222 and ZNF223 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ZNF family members.

Molecular Weight of ZNF222: 52 kDa.

Molecular Weight of ZNF223: 56 kDa.
