The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc finger proteins contain Krüppel-type DNA binding domains that are frequently observed to be involved in sequence-specific DNA binding. ZNF545 is a 532 amino acid transcriptional regulator belonging to the Krüppel C_2H_2 -type zinc finger protein family. ZNF545 localizes to the nucleus and contains 13 C_2H_2 -type zinc fingers and a KRAB domain. Two isoforms of ZNF545 are formed due to alternative splicing. ZNF545 is encoded by a gene located on chromosome 19, which contains a diversity of interesting genes and is recognized for having the greatest gene density of the human chromosomes. Chromosome 19 is the genetic home for a number of immunoglobulin superfamily members, including the killer cell and leukocyte lg-like receptors, a number of ICAMs, the CEACAM and PSG family and Fc receptors (FcR). Key genes for eye color and hair color also map to chromosome 19.

APPLICATIONS

ZNF545 (E-12) is recommended for detection of ZNF545 isoforms 1 and 2 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ZNF family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF545 siRNA (h): sc-97866.
