The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Made up of nearly 146 million bases, chromosome 8 encodes about 800 genes. Translocation of portions of chromosome 8 with amplifications of the c-Myc gene are found in some leukemias and lymphomas, and typically associated with a poor prognosis. Portions of chromosome 8 have been linked to schizophrenia and bipolar disorder. Trisomy 8, also known as Warkany syndrome 2, most often results in early miscarriage but is occasionally seen in a mosaic form in surviving patients who suffer to a varying degree from a number of symptoms including retarded mental and motor development, and certain facial and developmental defects. WRN is a DNA helicase encoded by chromosome 8 and shown defective in those with the early aging disorder Werner syndrome. Chromosome 8 is also associated with Pfeiffer syndrome, congenital hypothyroidism and Waardenburg syndrome. The C8orf77 gene product has been provisionally designated C8orf77 pending further characterization.

Store at 4° C, **D0 NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: C8orf77 (human) mapping to 8q24.3.

SOURCE

C8orf77 (U-23) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic C8orf77 peptide of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 50 μ g IgG in 500 μ l PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide, 0.1% gelatin and < 0.02% sucrose.

APPLICATIONS

C8orf77 (U-23) is recommended for detection of C8orf77 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μ g per 100-500 μ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)] and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for C8orf77 siRNA (h): sc-77628, C8orf77 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-77628-SH and C8orf77 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-77628-V.


