The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

The BTB (Broad-Complex, Tramtrack and Bric-a-brac) domain, also known as the POZ (POxvirus and Zinc finger) domain, is an N-terminal homodimerization domain that contains multiple copies of kelch repeats and/or C_2H_2 -type zinc fingers. Proteins that contain BTB domains are thought to be involved in transcriptional regulation via control of chromatin structure and function. KCTD10 (potassium channel tetramerisation domain containing 10), also known as ULR061 or MSTP028, is a 313 amino acid protein that contains one BTB domain and is highly expressed in lung and moderately expressed in heart and testis. KCTD10 interacts with proliferating cell nuclear antigen (PCNA) and the small subunit of polymerase δ and plays a role in DNA repair, DNA replication and cell-cycle control. KCTD10 expression is regulated by SP1 and AP-2 α .

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 KCTD10 interacts with proliferating cell nuclear antigen and its down-regulation could inhibit cell proliferation. J. Cell. Biochem. 106: 409-413.

Genetic locus: KCTD10 (human) mapping to 12g24.11.

SOURCE

KCTD10 (H-24) is a Protein A purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic KCTD10 peptide of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 100 μ g IgG in 1.0 ml PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide, 0.1% gelatin and < 0.02% sucrose.

APPLICATIONS

KCTD10 (H-24) is recommended for detection of KCTD10 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μ g per 100-500 μ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)] and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).


