# PQLC1 (K-22): sc-133922



The Power to Question

### **BACKGROUND**

PQLC1 (PQ-loop repeat-containing protein 1) is a 271 amino acid protein encoded by a gene located on human chromosome 18. Encoding over 300 genes, chromosome 18 contains about 76 million bases. Trisomy 18, or Edwards syndrome, is the second most common trisomy after Downs syndrome. Symptoms of Edwards syndrome include low birth weight, a variety of physical development defects, heart deformations and breathing difficulty. Translocation between chromosome 18 and 14 is the most common translocation in cancers, and occurs in follicular lymphomas. Niemann-Pick disease, hereditary hemorrhagic telangiectasia and erythropoietic protoporphyria are associated with chromosome 18. The TGFb modulators, Smad2, Smad4 and Smad7 are encoded by chromosome 18.

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# **CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION**

Genetic locus: PQLC1 (human) mapping to 18q23.

## **SOURCE**

PQLC1 (K-22) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic PQLC1 peptide of human origin.

### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 50  $\mu g$  lgG in 500  $\mu l$  PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide, 0.1% gelatin and < 0.02% sucrose.

# **STORAGE**

Store at 4° C, \*\*DO NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

### **APPLICATIONS**

PQLC1 (K-22) is recommended for detection of PQLC1 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μg per 100-500 μg of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)] and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000)

Suitable for use as control antibody for PQLC1 siRNA (h): sc-76210, PQLC1 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-76210-SH and PQLC1 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-76210-V.

Molecular Weight (predicted) of PQLC1: 30 kDa.




Positive Controls: HeLa whole cell lysate: sc-2200 or Jurkat whole cell lysate: sc-2204.


## **RECOMMENDED SECONDARY REAGENTS**

To ensure optimal results, the following support (secondary) reagents are recommended: 1) Western Blotting: use goat anti-rabbit IgG-HRP: sc-2004 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:100,000) or Cruz Marker™ compatible goat anti-rabbit IgG-HRP: sc-2030 (dilution range: 1:2000-1:5000), Cruz Marker™ Molecular Weight Standards: sc-2035, TBS Blotto A Blocking Reagent: sc-2333 and Western Blotting Luminol Reagent: sc-2048. 2) Immunoprecipitation: use Protein A/G PLUS-Agarose: sc-2003 (0.5 ml agarose/2.0 ml).
