The Power to Overtin

BACKGROUND

The leucine-rich (LRR) repeat is a 20-30 amino acid motif that forms a hydrophobic α/β horseshoe fold, allowing it to accommodate several leucine residues within a tightly packed core. All LRR repeats contain a variable segment and a highly conserved segment, the latter of which accounts for 11 or 12 residues of the entire LRR motif. PHLPPL (PH domain leucine-rich repeat protein phosphatase-like), also known as PHLPP2 (PH domain and leucine rich repeat protein phosphatase 2), is a 1,323 amino acid protein that contains 21 LRR repeats, as well as one PH domain and one PP2C-like domain. Localized to both the nucleus and the cytoplasm, PHLPPL uses manganese as a cofactor and mediates the dephosphorylation of Akt1, thereby playing a role in cell survival and apoptotic regulation. Multiple isoforms of PHLPPL exist due to alternative splicing events.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: PHLPPL (human) mapping to 16q22.2; Phlppl (mouse) mapping to 8 D3.

SOURCE

PHLPPL (T-17) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the N-terminus of PHLPPL of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-137663 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

APPLICATIONS

PHLPPL (T-17) is recommended for detection of PHLPPL of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μ g per 100-500 μ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

PHLPPL (T-17) is also recommended for detection of PHLPPL in additional species, including equine, canine and bovine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for PHLPPL siRNA (h): sc-93087, PHLPPL siRNA (m): sc-152230, PHLPPL shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-93087-SH, PHLPPL shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-152230-SH, PHLPPL shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-93087-V and PHLPPL shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-152230-V.




RECOMMENDED SECONDARY REAGENTS
