ZDHHC4 (T-11): sc-137955



BACKGROUND

Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. ZDHHC4 (zinc finger, DHHC domain containing 4), also known as ZNF374, is a 344 amino acid multi-pass membrane protein that contains one DHHC-type zinc finger and is thought to function as a palmitoyltransferase, catalyzing the transformation of palmitoyl-CoA and a cysteine-conjugated protein to a S-palmitoyl protein and free CoA. The gene encoding ZDHHC4 maps to human chromosome 7, which houses over 1,000 genes and comprises nearly 5% of the human genome. Defects in some of the genes localized to chromosome 7 have been linked to Osteogenesis imperfecta, Williams-Beuren syndrome, Pendred syndrome, Lissencephaly, Citrullinemia and Shwachman-Diamond syndrome.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: ZDHHC4 (human) mapping to 7p22.1; Zdhhc4 (mouse) mapping to 5 G2.

SOURCE

ZDHHC4 (T-11) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the C-terminus of ZDHHC4 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-137955 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **D0 NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

APPLICATIONS

ZDHHC4 (T-11) is recommended for detection of ZDHHC4 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ZDHHC family members.

ZDHHC4 (T-11) is also recommended for detection of ZDHHC4 in additional species, including equine and bovine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZDHHC4 siRNA (h): sc-89638, ZDHHC4 siRNA (m): sc-155504, ZDHHC4 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-89638-SH, ZDHHC4 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-155504-SH, ZDHHC4 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-89638-V and ZDHHC4 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-155504-V.
