MPND (E-15): sc-138997



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Proteases are enzymes that are involved in protein catabolism by hydrolyzing the peptide bonds between amino acids in a polypeptide chain. MPND (MPN domain-containing protein) is a 471 amino acid protein that is thought to be a protease. Expressed as two isoforms produced by alternative splicing, MPND contains a JAMM motif and one MPN domain. The gene that encodes MPND maps to human chromosome 19, which consists of around 63 million bases with over 1,400 genes, making up over 2% of human genomic DNA. Chromosome 19 includes a diversity of interesting genes and is recognized for having the greatest gene density of the human chromosomes. It is the genetic home for a number of immunoglobulin superfamily members including the killer cell and leukocyte lg-like receptors, a number of ICAMs, the CEACAM and PSG family and Fc α receptors. Key genes for eye color and hair color also map to chromosome 19.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: MPND (human) mapping to 19p13.3; Mpnd (mouse) mapping to 17 D.

SOURCE

MPND (E-15) is an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of MPND of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 100 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-138997 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

MPND (E-15) is recommended for detection of MPND of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:100, dilution range 1:50-1:500), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:25, dilution range 1:25-1:250) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

MPND (E-15) is also recommended for detection of MPND in additional species, including canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for MPND siRNA (h): sc-97324, MPND siRNA (m): sc-149532, MPND shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-97324-SH, MPND shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-149532-SH, MPND shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-97324-V and MPND shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-149532-V.
