SYCE1 (E-12): sc-139072



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

SYCE1 (synaptonemal complex central element protein 1), also known as CT76 (cancer/testis antigen 76), is a 351 amino acid nuclear protein that belongs to the SYCE family and exists as three alternatively spliced isoforms. Colocalizing with SYCE2 on chromatin, SYCE1 exists as a homodimer and is found in the transverse central elements of the central region between lateral elements of the synaptonemal complexes (SCS). The transverse central element of the SCS is formed between homologous chromosomes during meiotic prophase and requires SYCP1. The gene that encodes SYCE1 maps to human chromosome 10q26.3. Spanning nearly 135 million base pairs, chromosome 10 makes up approximately 4.5% of total DNA in cells and encodes nearly 1,200 genes. Defects in some of the genes that map to chromosome 10 are associated with Charcot-Marie Tooth disease, Jackson-Weiss syndrome, Usher syndrome, nonsyndromatic deafness, Wolman's syndrome, Cowden syndrome, multiple endocrine neoplasia type 2 and porphyria.

Genetic locus: SYCE1 (human) mapping to 10q26.3.

SYCE1 (E-12) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of SYCE1 of human origin.

APPLICATIONS

SYCE1 (E-12) is recommended for detection of SYCE1 isoforms 1-3 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with SYCE2.

Suitable for use as control antibody for SYCE1 siRNA (h): sc-90491, SYCE1 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-90491-SH and SYCE1 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-90491-V.

Molecular Weight of SYCE1 isoforms: 40/33/22 kDa.
