SRSP1 (N-20): sc-139434



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

SRSP1, also known as SPATS1 (spermatogenesis associated, serine-rich 1) or SPATA8, is a 300 amino acid protein that exists as 2 alternatively spliced isoforms and may play a role in spermatogenesis. The gene encoding SRSP1 maps to human chromosome 6, which contains 170 million base pairs and comprises nearly 6% of the human genome. Deletion of a portion of the q arm of chromosome 6 is associated with early onset intestinal cancer, suggesting the presence of a cancer susceptibility locus. Additionally, porphyria cutanea tarda, Parkinson's disease, Stickler syndrome and a susceptibility to bipolar disorder are all associated with genes that map to chromosome 6.

APPLICATIONS

SRSP1 (N-20) is recommended for detection of SRSP1 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:100, dilution range 1:50-1:500), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:25, dilution range 1:25-1:250) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with SPATA10.

Suitable for use as control antibody for SRSP1 siRNA (h): sc-95320, SRSP1 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-95320-SH and SRSP1 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-95320-V.
