# Peroxin 11β (V-13): sc-160660



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

Peroxisomes are single-membrane bound organelles present in virtually all eukaryotic cells. They are involved in numerous catabolic and anabolic pathways, including  $\beta$ -oxidation of very long chain fatty acids, metabolism of hydrogen peroxide, plasmalogen biosynthesis and bile acid synthesis. The Peroxin gene family, which includes more than 20 members, is required for peroxisome biogenesis. Peroxin 11 $\beta$ , also known as PEX11 $\beta$  (peroxisomal biogenesis factor 11  $\beta$ ), is a 259 amino acid single-pass membrane protein belonging to the Peroxin 11 family. Involved in peroxisomal proliferation, Peroxin 11 $\beta$  may participate in regulating peroxisomes division by recruiting the Dynamin-related GTPase DRP1 to the peroxisomal membrane. Peroxin 11 $\beta$  associates with Peroxin 19 and is encoded by a gene mapping to human chromosome 1q21.1

## SOURCE

Peroxin 11 $\beta$  (V-13) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of Peroxin 11 $\beta$  of human origin.

#### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-160660 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

#### **APPLICATIONS**

Peroxin 11 $\beta$  (V-13) is recommended for detection of Peroxin 11 $\beta$  of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with Peroxin 11 $\alpha$  or Peroxin 11 $\gamma$ .

Peroxin 11 $\beta$  (V-13) is also recommended for detection of Peroxin 11 $\beta$  in additional species, including equine, canine and bovine.
