BRP44L (D-14): sc-160976



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

BRP44L (brain protein 44-like protein), also known as HSPC040 or CGI-129, is a 109 amino acid mitochondrial protein belonging to the UPF0041 family. The gene that encodes BRP44L maps to human chromosome 6. Making up nearly 6% of the human genome, chromosome 6 contains around 1,200 genes within 170 million base pairs of sequence. Deletion of a portion of the q arm of chromosome 6 is associated with early onset intestinal cancer suggesting the presence of a cancer susceptibility locus. Porphyria cutanea tarda is associated with chromosome 6 through the HFE gene which, when mutated, predisposes an individual to developing this porphyria. Notably, the PARK2 gene, which is associated with Parkinson's disease, and the genes encoding the major histocompatiblity complex proteins, which are key molecular components of the immune system and determine predisposition to rheumatic diseases, are also located on chromosome 6. Stickler syndrome, 21-hydroxylase deficiency and maple syrup urine disease are also associated with genes on chromosome 6. A bipolar disorder susceptibility locus has been identified on the q arm of chromosome 6.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: BRP44L (human) mapping to 6q27, LOC347411 (human) mapping to Xp11.4; Brp44l (mouse) mapping to 17 A1.

SOURCE

BRP44L (D-14) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of BRP44L of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-160976 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

BRP44L (D-14) is recommended for detection of BRP44L and LOC347411 of human origin and BRP44L of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with BRP44.

BRP44L (D-14) is also recommended for detection of BRP44L and LOC347411 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine, porcine and avian.

Suitable for use as control antibody for BRP44L siRNA (m): sc-141751, BRP44L shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-141751-SH and BRP44L shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-141751-V.
