The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

FDC-SP (follicular dendritic cell secreted peptide) is an 85 amino acid secreted protein that binds the surface of B-lymphoma cells and is implicated in B-cell mediation. Expressed at highest levels in lymph node, tonsil, trachea and prostate, FDC-SP is also found at lower levels in colon, stomach and thyroid. The gene encoding FDC-S maps to human chromosome 4, which contains nearly 900 genes. Notably, the Huntingtin gene, which is found to encode an expanded glutamine tract in cases of Huntington's disease, is on chromosome 4. FGFR-3 is also encoded on chromosome 4 and has been associated with thanatophoric dwarfism, achondroplasia, Muenke syndrome and bladder cancer. Chromosome 4 is also tied to Ellis-van Creveld syndrome, methylmalonic acidemia and polycystic kidney disease. Chromosome 4 reportedly contains the largest gene deserts (regions of the genome with no protein encoding genes) and has one of the two lowest recombination frequencies of the human chromosomes.

FDC-SP (R-12) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping at the C-terminus of FDC-SP of rat origin.

APPLICATIONS

FDC-SP (R-12) is recommended for detection of FDC-SP of rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Molecular Weight (observed) of FDC-SP: 19-22 kDa.
