NRIP2 (E-12): sc-161961



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

NRIP2 (nuclear receptor interacting protein 2) is a 281 amino acid nuclear protein that downregulates transcriptional activation by nuclear receptors such as ROR β . The gene encoding NRIP2 maps to human chromosome 12, which encodes over 1,100 genes and comprises approximately 4.5% of the human genome. Chromosome 12 is associated with a variety of diseases and afflictions, including hypochondrogenesis, achondrogenesis, Kniest dysplasia, Noonan syndrome and Trisomy 12p, which causes facial developmental defects and seizure disorders.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: NRIP2 (human) mapping to 12p13.33; Nrip2 (mouse) mapping to 6 F3.

SOURCE

NRIP2 (E-12) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the N-terminus of NRIP2 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-161961 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

NRIP2 (E-12) is recommended for detection of NRIP2 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with NRIP or NRIP3.

Suitable for use as control antibody for NRIP2 siRNA (h): sc-96104, NRIP2 siRNA (m): sc-150066, NRIP2 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-96104-SH, NRIP2 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-150066-SH, NRIP2 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-96104-V and NRIP2 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-150066-V.
