The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

2200002D01Rik is a 114 amino acid protein encoded by a gene that maps to mouse chromosome 7 B1. The human homolog of this protein, known as H2RSP (hepatocyte growth factor activator inhibitor type 2-related small protein), IMUP (immortalization up-regulated protein) or C19orf33, is a 106 amino acid protein that exists as 2 alternatively spliced isoforms. The gene that encodes H2RSP is made up of approximately 843 bases and maps to human chromosome 19. Consisting of around 63 million bases with more than 1,400 genes, chromosome 19 makes up over 2% of the human genome. It is the genetic home for a number of immunoglobulin superfamily members including the killer cell and *leukocyte lg-like receptors, a number of ICAMs, the CEACAM and PSG families, and $Fc\alpha$ receptors. Peutz-Jeghers syndrome, spinocerebellar ataxia type 6, the stroke disorder CADASIL, hypercholesterolemia and Insulin-dependent diabetes have been linked to chromosome 19.

Genetic locus: 2200002D01Rik (mouse) mapping to 7 B1.

SOURCE

2200002D01Rik (A-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of 2200002D01Rik of mouse origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-162447 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **D0 NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

APPLICATIONS

2200002D01Rik (A-15) is recommended for detection of 2200002D01Rik of mouse origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for 2200002D01Rik siRNA (m): sc-108610, 2200002D01Rik shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-108610-SH and 2200002D01Rik shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-108610-V.
