# MACC1 (D-15): sc-163595



The Power to Question

#### BACKGROUND

Chromosome 7 is about 158 million bases long, encodes over 1,000 genes and makes up about 5% of the human genome. Chromosome 7 has been linked to osteogenesis imperfecta, Pendred syndrome, lissencephaly, citrullinemia and Shwachman-Diamond syndrome. The deletion of a portion of the q arm of chromosome 7 is associated with Williams-Beuren syndrome, a condition characterized by mild mental retardation, an unusual comfort and friendliness with strangers and an elfin appearance. Deletions of portions of the q arm of chromosome 7 are also seen in a number of myeloid disorders including cases of acute myelogenous leukemia and myelodysplasia.

Genetic locus: MACC1 (human) mapping to 7p21.1; Macc1 (mouse) mapping to 12 F2.

## SOURCE

MACC1 (D-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of MACC1 of human origin.

## PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-163595 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

#### APPLICATIONS

MACC1 (D-15) is recommended for detection of MACC1 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2  $\mu$ g per 100-500  $\mu$ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

MACC1 (D-15) is also recommended for detection of MACC1 in additional species, including canine, bovine and avian.

Suitable for use as control antibody for MACC1 siRNA (h): sc-89466, MACC1 siRNA (m): sc-108958, MACC1 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-89466-SH, MACC1 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-108958-SH, MACC1 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-89466-V and MACC1 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-108958-V.

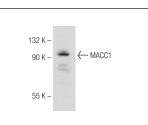
