BACKGROUND

FBXO47 (F-box only protein 47) is a 452 amino acid protein that contains one 40 amino acid F-box region, making it a member of the F-box family. F-box proteins are critical components of the SCF (Skp1-CUL-1-F-box protein) type E3 ubiquitin ligase complex and are involved in substrate recognition and recruitment for ubiquitination. F-box proteins are members of a large family that regulates cell cycle, immune response, signaling cascades and developmental programs by targeting proteins, such as cyclins, cyclin-dependent kinase inhibitors, $I\kappa B-\alpha$ and β -catenin, for degradation by the proteasome after ubiquitination. Functioning as a component of the SCF complex, FBXO47 is thought to recognize and bind to select phosphorylated proteins, thereby promoting their ubiquitination and subsequent degradation. FBXO7 is widely expressed with highest expression in kidney, liver and pancreas, and is down-regulated in tumors. Therefore, FBXO47 may be a potential tumor-suppressor gene.

SOURCE

FBXO47 (M-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the C-terminus of FBXO47 of mouse origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-167875 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

FBX047 (M-15) is recommended for detection of FBX047 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other FBX0 family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for FBXO47 siRNA (m): sc-145131, FBXO47 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-145131-SH and FBXO47 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-145131-V.
