ZNF192 (G-14): sc-169889



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Zinc-finger proteins contain DNA-binding domains and have a wide variety of functions, most of which encompass some form of transcriptional activation or repression. The majority of zinc-finger proteins contain a Krüppel-type DNA binding domain and a KRAB domain, which is thought to interact with KAP1, thereby recruiting histone modifying proteins. Zinc finger protein 177 (ZNF177) is a 321 amino acid member of the Krüppel C_2H_2 -type zinc-finger protein family. ZNF177 localizes to the nucleus and contains seven C_2H_2 -type zinc fingers and one KRAB domain, through which it is thought to be involved in DNA-binding and transcriptional regulation.

Genetic locus: ZNF192 (human) mapping to 6p22.1; Zfp192 (mouse) mapping to 13 A3.1.

SOURCE

ZNF192 (G-14) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of ZNF192 of human origin.

RESEARCH USE

For research use only, not for use in diagnostic procedures.

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

APPLICATIONS

ZNF192 (G-14) is recommended for detection of ZNF192 of human origin and ZFP192 of mouse origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other ZNF family members.

ZNF192 (G-14) is also recommended for detection of ZNF192 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for ZNF192 siRNA (h): sc-95295, ZFP192 siRNA (m): sc-155536, ZNF192 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-95295-SH, ZFP192 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-155536-SH, ZNF192 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-95295-V and ZFP192 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-155536-V.
