The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Cactin, also known as fSAPc, NY-REN-24 or C19orf29, is a 758 amino acid nuclear protein that colocalizes with NFKBIL1 (NFkB inhibitor-like protein 1). Involved in the regulation of innate immune responses, Cactin may play a role in early embryonic development and pre-mRNA splicing. Cactin acts as a negative regulator of Toll-like receptor and IRF (interferon-regulatory factor) signaling pathways. In response to endogenous pro-inflammatory stimuli, Cactin regulates the transcriptional activation of NFkB genes. The gene encoding Cactin, which maps to human chromosome 19p13.3 and mouse chromosome 10 C1, may be associated with renal-cell carcinoma patients. Cactin exists as two alternatively spliced isoforms.

Cactin (D-16) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of Cactin of human origin.

APPLICATIONS

Cactin (D-16) is recommended for detection of Cactin of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 µg per 100-500 µg of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other C19orf family members.


Cactin (D-16) is also recommended for detection of Cactin in additional species, including canine, bovine and porcine.
