# LYRM2 (K-16): sc-240641



The Power to Question

### **BACKGROUND**

LYRM2 (LYR motif containing 2), also known as FLJ18193, FLJ18317, FLJ21130, DJ12208.2 or MGC104253, is an 88 amino acid protein belonging to the complex I LYR family. LYRM2 is encoded by a gene located on human chromosome 6, which contains 170 million base pairs and comprises nearly 6% of the human genome. Deletion of a portion of the q arm of chromosome 6 is associated with early onset intestinal cancer, suggesting the presence of a cancer susceptibility locus. Additionally, Porphyria cutanea tarda, Parkinson's disease, Stickler syndrome and a susceptibility to bipolar disorder are all associated with genes that map to chromosome 6.

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## **CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION**

Genetic locus: Lyrm2 (mouse) mapping to 4 A5.

#### **STORAGE**

Store at 4° C, \*\*DO NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

#### **SOURCE**

LYRM2 (K-16) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of LYRM2 of mouse origin.

### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-240641 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

### **APPLICATIONS**

LYRM2 (K-16) is recommended for detection of LYRM2 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other LYRM family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for LYRM2 siRNA (m): sc-149185, LYRM2 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-149185-SH and LYRM2 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-149185-V.

Molecular Weight of LYRM2: 10 kDa.
