The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

The cytochrome c oxidase (COX) family of proteins function as the final electron donor in the respiratory chain to drive a proton gradient across the inner mitochondrial membrane, ultimately resulting in the production of water. C1orf31, also known as COA6, is a 125 amino acid mitochondrial protein that belongs to the cytochrome c oxidase subunit 6B family. There are three isoforms of C1orf31 that are produced as a result of alternative splicing events. The gene encoding C1orf31 maps to human chromosome 1, the largest human chromosome spanning about 260 million base pairs and making up 8% of the human genome. There are about 3,000 genes on chromosome 1, and considering the great number of genes there are also a large number of diseases associated with chromosome 1. Notably, the rare aging disease Hutchinson-Gilford progeria is associated with the LMNA gene which encodes lamin A. When defective, the LMNA gene product can build up in the nucleus and cause characteristic nuclear blebs. The mechanism of rapidly enhanced aging is unclear and is a topic of continuing exploration.

COA6 (D-14) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of COA6 of mouse origin.

APPLICATIONS

COA6 (D-14) is recommended for detection of COA6 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for COA6 siRNA (m): sc-108580, COA6 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-108580-SH and COA6 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-108580-V.
