The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

SIMC1 (SUMO-interacting motif-containing protein 1), also known as OOMA1 or C5orf25, is an 872 amino acid protein that interacts with SUMO-1 and SUMO-2 via two N-terminal SIM domains. SIMC1 becomes phosphorylated upon DNA damage at Serine 651 and 791. Existing as four alternatively spliced isoforms, SIMC1 is encoded by a gene that maps to human chromosome 5q35.2. With 181 million base pairs encoding around 1,000 genes, chromosome 5 is about 6% of human genomic DNA. It is associated with Cockayne syndrome through the ERCC8 gene and familial adenomatous polyposis through the adenomatous polyposis coli (APC) tumor suppressor gene. Treacher Collins syndrome is also chromosome 5 associated and is caused by insertions or deletions within the TCOF1 gene. Deletion of the p arm of chromosome 5 leads to cri du chat syndrome. Deletion of 5q or chromosome 5 altogether is common in therapy-related acute myelogenous leukemias and myelodysplastic syndrome.

Genetic locus: SIMC1 (human) mapping to 5q35.2; 4732471D19Rik (mouse) mapping to 13 B1.

SIMC1 (D-16) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of SIMC1 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

APPLICATIONS

SIMC1 (D-16) is recommended for detection of 4732471D19Rik of mouse origin and SIMC1 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).
