C5orf32 (K-19): sc-242200



The Boures to Overtion

BACKGROUND

With 181 million base pairs encoding around 1,000 genes, chromosome 5 is about 6% of human genomic DNA. It is associated with Cockayne syndrome through the ERCC8 gene and familial adenomatous polyposis through the adenomatous polyposis coli (APC) tumor suppressor gene. Treacher Collins syndrome is also chromosome 5 associated and is caused by insertions or deletions within the TCOF1 gene. Deletion of the p arm of chromosome 5 leads to Cri du chat syndrome. Deletion of 5q or chromosome 5 altogether is common in therapy-related acute myelogenous leukemias and myelodysplastic syndrome. The C5orf32 gene product has been provisionally designated C5orf32 pending further characterization.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: CYSTM1 (human) mapping to 5q31.3; Cystm1 (mouse) mapping to 18 B2.

SOURCE

C5orf32 (K-19) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of C5orf32 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-242200 P, ($100 \mu \text{g}$ peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

C5orf32 (K-19) is recommended for detection of C5orf32 of mouse and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

C5orf32 (K-19) is also recommended for detection of C5orf32 in additional species, including canine, bovine and porcine.
