# C9orf23 (N-20): sc-242273



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

C9orf23 (chromosome 9 open reading frame 23) is a 163 amino acid protein that belongs to the histone-like Alba family and is encoded by a gene that maps to human chromosome 9p13.3. Chromosome 9 consists of about 145 million bases, represents 4% of the human genome and encodes nearly 900 genes. Thought to play a role in gender determination, deletion of the distal portion of 9p can lead to development of male to female sex reversal, the phenotype of a female with a male X,Y genotype. Hereditary hemornagic telangiectasia, which is characterized by harmful vascular defects, is associated with the chromosome 9 gene encoding endoglin protein, ENG. Familial dysautonomia is also associated with chromosome 9 though through the gene IKBKAP. Notably, chromosome 9 encompasses the largest interferon family gene cluster. Chromosome 9 is partnered with chromosome 22 in the translocation leading to the aberrant production of Bcr-Abl fusion protein often found in leukemias.

#### **SOURCE**

C9orf23 (N-20) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping at the N-terminus of C9orf23 of human origin.

#### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-242273 P, (100 μg peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

#### **APPLICATIONS**

C9orf23 (N-20) is recommended for detection of C9orf23 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

C9orf23 (N-20) is also recommended for detection of C9orf23 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for C9orf23 siRNA (h): sc-92853, C9orf23 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-92853-SH and C9orf23 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-92853-V.

Molecular Weight of C9orf23: 18 kDa.
