# C9orf30 (E-15): sc-242276



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

C9orf30 (chromosome 9 open reading frame 30) is a 275 amino acid protein that is expressed in brain and belongs to the UPF0439 family. The gene encoding C9orf30 maps to human chromosome 9q31.1. Chromosome 9 consists of about 145 million bases, represents 4% of the human genome and encodes nearly 900 genes. Thought to play a role in gender determination, deletion of the distal portion of 9p can lead to development of male to female sex reversal, the phenotype of a female with a male X,Y genotype. Hereditary hemorrhagic telangiectasia, which is characterized by harmful vascular defects, is associated with the chromosome 9 gene encoding endoglin protein, ENG. Familial dysautonomia is also associated with chromosome 9 though through the gene IKBKAP. Notably, chromosome 9 encompasses the largest interferon family gene cluster. Chromosome 9 is partnered with chromosome 22 in the translocation leading to the aberrant production of BCR-ABL fusion protein often found in leukemias.

C9orf30 (E-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of C9orf30 of human origin.

#### **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-242276 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

## **APPLICATIONS**

C9orf30 (E-15) is recommended for detection of C9orf30 of human origin, 5730528L13Rik of mouse origin and the corresponding rat homolog by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

C9orf30 (E-15) is also recommended for detection of C9orf30 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine, porcine and avian.
