BACKGROUND

CASD1 (CAS1 domain containing 1) is a 797 amino acid multi-pass membrane protein that belongs to the CASD1 family. Sharing high homology with glycosyltransferases, CASD1 contains 15 putative transmembrane domains and is encoded by a gene that maps to human chromosome 7q21.3, a region associated with myoclonic dystonia. Chromosome 7 has been linked to osteogenesis imperfecta, Pendred syndrome, lissencephaly, citrullinemia and Shwachman-Diamond syndrome. The deletion of a portion of the q arm of chromosome 7 is associated with Williams-Beuren syndrome, a condition characterized by mild mental retardation, an unusual comfort and friendliness with strangers and an elfin appearance. Deletions of portions of the q arm of chromosome 7 are also seen in a number of myeloid disorders including cases of acute myelogenous leukemia and myelodysplasia.

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CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: CASD1 (human) mapping to 7q21.3; Casd1 (mouse) mapping to 6 A1.

SOURCE

CASD1 (E-13) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of CASD1 of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-242314 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

CASD1 (E-13) is recommended for detection of CASD1 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

CASD1 (E-13) is also recommended for detection of CASD1 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine, porcine and avian.
