# DCDC1 (K-15): sc-242551



The Power to Question

### **BACKGROUND**

DCDC1 (doublecortin domain containing 1), also known as FLJ44078, is a 354 amino acid member of the doublecortin protein family. DCDC1 is a hydrophilic, intracellular protein that contains one doublecortin domain. DCDC1 is unable to bind to microtubules and to regulate microtubule polymerization. DCDC1 is expressed highly in testis, with lower expression found in kidney, lung and pancreas. The gene that encodes DCDC1 maps to human chromosome 11, which makes up around 4% of human genomic DNA and is considered a gene and disease association dense chromosome. The chromosome 11 encoded Atm gene is important for regulation of cell cycle arrest and apoptosis following double strand DNA breaks. Atm mutation leads to the disorder known as ataxia-telangiectasia. The blood disorders Sickle cell anemia and  $\beta$  thalassemia are caused by HBB gene mutations. Wilms' tumors, WAGR syndrome and Denys-Drash syndrome are associated with mutations of the WT1 gene. Jervell and Lange-Nielsen syndrome, Jacobsen syndrome, Niemann-Pick disease, hereditary angioedema and Smith-Lemli-Opitz syndrome are also associated with defects in chromosome 11.

DCDC1 (K-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of DCDC1 of human origin.

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

# **APPLICATIONS**

DCDC1 (K-15) is recommended for detection of DCDC1 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with DCDC2 or DCDC5.

Suitable for use as control antibody for DCDC1 siRNA (h): sc-96399, DCDC1 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-96399-SH and DCDC1 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-96399-V.

Molecular Weight of DCDC1: 40 kDa.
