FAM134C (P-17): sc-242690



BACKGROUND

Chromosome 17 makes up over 2.5% of the human genome with about 81 million bases encoding over 1,200 genes. Two key tumor suppressor genes are associated with chromosome 17, namely, p53 and BRCA1. Tumor suppressor p53 is necessary for maintenance of cellular genetic integrity by moderating cell fate through DNA repair versus cell death. Malfunction or loss of p53 expression is associated with malignant cell growth and Li-Fraumeni syndrome. Like p53, BRCA1 is directly involved in DNA repair, though specifically it is recognized as a genetic determinant of early onset breast cancer and predisposition to cancers of the ovary, colon, prostate gland and fallopian tubes. Chromosome 17 is also linked to neurofibromatosis, a condition characterized by neural and epidermal lesions, and dysregu-lated Schwann cell growth. Alexander disease, Birt-Hogg-Dube syndrome and Canavan disease are also associated with chromosome 17. The FAM134C gene product has been provisionally designated FAM134C pending further characterization.

CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: FAM134C (human) mapping to 17q21.2; Fam134c (mouse) mapping to 11 D.

SOURCE

FAM134C (P-17) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of FAM134C of human origin.

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **DO NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-242690 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

FAM134C (P-17) is recommended for detection of FAM134C of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunoprecipitation [1-2 μ g per 100-500 μ g of total protein (1 ml of cell lysate)], immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with FAM134A.

FAM134C (P-17) is also recommended for detection of FAM134C in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for FAM134C siRNA (h): sc-93676, FAM134C siRNA (m): sc-145028, FAM134C shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-93676-SH, FAM134C shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-145028-SH, FAM134C shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-93676-V and FAM134C shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-145028-V.


