The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

CLU1, also known as KIAA0664, is a 1,309 amino acid protein that contains 4 tetratricopeptide (TPR) repeats and belongs to the CLU1/TIF31 family. Consisting of around 34 amino acids, each TPR repeat functions to promote protein-protein interactions. The gene that encodes CLU1 is made up of more than 22,000 bases and maps to human chromosome 17p13.3. Encoding more than 1,200 genes, chromosome 17 comprises over 2.5% of the human genome. Two key tumor suppressor genes are associated with chromosome 17, namely, p53 and BRCA1. Tumor suppressor p53 is necessary for maintenance of cellular genetic integrity by moderating cell fate through DNA repair versus cell death. Malfunction or loss of p53 expression is associated with malignant cell growth and Li-Fraumeni syndrome. Like p53, BRCA1 is directly involved in DNA repair, though specifically it is recognized as a genetic determinant of early onset breast cancer and predisposition to cancers of ovary, colon, prostate gland and fallopian tubes.

CLU1 (D-19) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the N-terminus of CLU1 of human origin.

APPLICATIONS

CLU1 (D-19) is recommended for detection of CLU1 of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

CLU1 (D-19) is also recommended for detection of KIAA0664 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine, porcine and avian.
