BACKGROUND

LPRP (lacrimal proline-rich protein), also known as PRR4 (proline rich 4), PROL4 or nasopharyngeal carcinoma-associated proline-rich protein 4, is a 134 amino acid secreted protein that is highly expressed in acinar cells of the lacrimal gland, but not intralobular ducts. LPRP is also found in parotid, sublingual and submandibular glands. Thought to play a role in protection of the eye via regulation of microflora, LPRP is a putative marker for lacrimal gland acinar cell function. The gene encoding LPRP maps to human chromosome 12, which encodes over 1,100 genes and comprises approximately 4.5% of the human genome. Chromosome 12 is associated with a variety of diseases and afflictions, including hypochondrogenesis, achondrogenesis, Kniest dysplasia, Noonan syndrome and trisomy 12p, which causes facial developmental defects and seizure disorders.

APPLICATIONS

LPRP (P-17) is recommended for detection of LPRP of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for LPRP siRNA (h): sc-95971, LPRP shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-95971-SH and LPRP shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-95971-V.

Molecular Weight of LPRP: 15 kDa.
