# LRRC37B (N-19): sc-243340



The Power to Question

#### BACKGROUND

The leucine-rich (LRR) repeat is a 20-30 amino acid motif that forms a hydrophobic  $\alpha/\beta$  horseshoe fold, allowing it to accommodate several leucine residues within a tightly packed core. All LRR repeats contain a variable segment and a highly conserved segment, the latter of which accounts for 11 or 12 residues of the entire LRR motif. The primary function of these motifs is to provide a versatile structural framework to mediate the formation of protein-protein interactions. LRRs are present in a variety of proteins with diverse structure and function, including innate immunity and nervous system development. Several human diseases are associated with mutations in genes encoding LRR-containing proteins. LRRC37B (leucine-rich repeat-containing protein 37B), also known as C66 SLIT-like testicular protein, is a 947 amino acid membrane protein that contains 6 LRR (leucine-rich) repeats and is encoded by a gene located on human chromosome 17q11.2.

Genetic locus: LRRC37B (human) mapping to 17q11.2.

#### SOURCE

LRRC37B (N-19) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an extracellular domain of LRRC37B of human origin.

## **STORAGE**

Store at 4° C, \*\*DO NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

## PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-243340 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

# **APPLICATIONS**

LRRC37B (N-19) is recommended for detection of LRRC37B of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with LRRC37A, LRRC37A2 or LRRC37A3.

Suitable for use as control antibody for LRRC37B siRNA (h): sc-94103, LRRC37B shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-94103-SH and LRRC37B shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-94103-V.

Molecular Weight of LRRC37B: 106 kDa.
