The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

RIBC1 (RIB43A-like with coiled-coils protein 1) is a 379 amino acid protein that belongs to the RIB43A family. Existing as two alternatively spliced isoforms, the RIBC1 gene is conserved in chimpanzee, canine, bovine, mouse, rat and zebrafish, and maps to human chromosome X11.22. The X and Y chromosomes are the human sex chromosomes. Chromosome X consists of about 153 million base pairs and nearly 1,000 genes. The combination of an X and Y chromosome lead to normal male development while two copies of X lead to normal female development. There are a number of conditions related to an unsual number and combination of sex chromosomes being inherited. More than one copy of the X chromosome with a Y chromosome causes Klinefelter's syndrome. A single copy of X alone leads to Turner's syndrome. More than 2 copies of the X chromosome, in the absence of a Y chromosome, is known as Triple X syndrome. Color blindness, hemophilia, and Duchenne muscular dystrophy are well known X chromosome-linked conditions which affect males more frequently as males carry a single X chromosome

Genetic locus: Ribc1 (mouse) mapping to X F3.

RIBC1 (L-19) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping near the C-terminus of RIBC1 of mouse origin.

PRODUCT

APPLICATIONS

RIBC1 (L-19) is recommended for detection of RIBC1 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

RIBC1 (L-19) is also recommended for detection of RIBC1 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for RIBC1 siRNA (m): sc-152890, RIBC1 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-152890-SH and RIBC1 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-152890-V.
