C6orf130 (K-15): sc-245840



The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

Making up nearly 6% of the human genome, chromosome 6 contains around 1,200 genes within 170 million base pairs of sequence. Deletion of a portion of the q arm of chromosome 6 is associated with early onset intestinal cancer suggesting the presence of a cancer susceptibility locus. Porphyria cutanea tarda is associated with chromosome 6 through the HFE gene which, when mutated, predisposes an individual to developing this porphyria. Notably, the PARK2 gene, which is associated with Parkinson's disease, and the genes encoding the major histocompatibility complex proteins, which are key molecular components of the immune system and determine predisposition to rheumatic diseases, are also located on chromosome 6. Stickler syndrome, 21-hydroxylase deficiency and maple syrup urine disease are also associated with genes on chromosome 6. A bipolar disorder susceptibility locus has been identified on the q arm of chromosome 6. The C6orf130 gene product has been provisionally designated C6orf130 pending further characterization.

Genetic locus: OARD1 (human) mapping to 6p21.1; Al314976 (mouse) mapping to 17 $\rm C.$

C6orf130 (K-15) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of C6orf130 of human origin.

RESEARCH USE

For research use only, not for use in diagnostic procedures.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-245840 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

C6orf130 (K-15) is recommended for detection of C6orf130 of human origin and Al314976 of mouse origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

C6orf130 (K-15) is also recommended for detection of C6orf130 in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for C6orf130 siRNA (h): sc-95227, Al314976 siRNA (m): sc-140925, C6orf130 shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-95227-SH, Al314976 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-140925-SH, C6orf130 shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-95227-V and Al314976 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-140925-V.
