BACKGROUND

FAM71A is a 594 amino acid protein that belongs to the FAM71 family. The gene encoding FAM71A maps to human chromosome 1, which spans 260 million base pairs, contains over 3,000 genes and comprises nearly 8% of the human genome. Chromosome 1 houses a large number of disease-associated genes, including those that are involved in familial adenomatous polyposis, Stickler syndrome, Parkinson's disease, Gaucher disease, schizophrenia and Usher syndrome. Aberrations in chromosome 1 are found in a variety of cancers, including head and neck cancer, malignant melanoma and multiple myeloma.

Genetic locus: FAM71A (human) mapping to 1q32.3.

SOURCE

FAM71A (K-19) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of FAM71A of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-246738 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

STORAGE

Store at 4° C, **D0 NOT FREEZE**. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

APPLICATIONS

FAM71A (K-19) is recommended for detection of FAM71A of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other FAM71 family members.

Suitable for use as control antibody for FAM71A siRNA (h): sc-88144, FAM71A shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-88144-SH and FAM71A shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-88144-V.

Molecular Weight of FAM71A: 63 kDa.
