The Power to Question

BACKGROUND

GOLGA2L1 (golgin subfamily A member 2-like protein 1), also known as GOLGA2B (golgin subfamily A member 2B), is a 144 amino acid protein that belongs to the GOLGA2 family. Existing as two alternatively spliced isoforms, the gene that encodes GOLGA2L1 maps to human chromosome 12, which makes up approximately 4.5% of the human genome. A number of skeletal deformities are linked to chromosome 12, including hypochondrogenesis, achondrogenesis and Kniest dysplasia. Noonan syndrome, which includes heart and facial developmental defects among the primary symptoms, is caused by a mutant form of the PTPN11 gene product, SH-PTP2. Chromosome 12 is also home to a homeobox gene cluster which encodes crucial transcription factors for morphogenesis, as well as the natural killer complex gene cluster, which encodes C-type lectin proteins that mediate the NK cell response to MHC I interaction.

GOLGA2L1 (S-16) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of GOLGA2L1 of human origin.

GOLGA2L1 (S-16) is recommended for detection of GOLGA2L1 of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).
