# KIF24 (P-20): sc-247348



The Power to Question

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Kinesins constitute a large family of microtubule-dependent motor proteins which are responsible for the distribution of numerous organelles, vesicles and macromolecular complexes throughout the cell. Individual Kinesin members play crucial roles in cell division, intracellular transport and membrane trafficking events, including endocytosis and transcytosis. KIF24 (Kinesin family member 24) is a 1,368 amino acid cytoplasmic and cytoskeletal protein that belongs to the Kinesin-like protein family. Existing as four alternatively spliced isoforms, KIF24 contains one Kinesin-motor domain and a single SAM (sterile  $\alpha$  motif) domain. KIF24 is phosphorylated on multiple amino acid residues and is encoded by a gene that maps to human chromosome 9p13.3.

# CHROMOSOMAL LOCATION

Genetic locus: Kif24 (mouse) mapping to 4 A5.

### **SOURCE**

KIF24 (P-20) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of KIF24 of mouse origin.

## **PRODUCT**

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  lgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with <0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-247348 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

# **STORAGE**

Store at 4° C, \*\*DO NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

### **APPLICATIONS**

KIF24 (P-20) is recommended for detection of KIF24 of mouse and rat origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with other KIF family members.

KIF24 (P-20) is also recommended for detection of KIF24 in additional species, including equine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for KIF24 siRNA (m): sc-146471, KIF24 shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-146471-SH and KIF24 shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-146471-V.

Molecular Weight of KIF24 isoforms: 152/136/24/129 kDa.
