# LCAP (G-20): sc-247410



#### BACKGROUND

LCAP, also known as LCA10 (lung carcinoma-associated protein 10), is a 164 amino acid protein encoded by a gene that maps to human chromosome Xq28. The X and Y chromosomes are the human sex chromosomes. Chromosome X consists of about 153 million base pairs and nearly 1,000 genes. The combination of an X and Y chromosome lead to normal male development while two copies of X lead to normal female development. There are a number of conditions related to an unusual number and combination of sex chromosomes being inherited, including Turner's syndrome, Klinefelter's syndrome and Triple X syndrome. Color blindness, hemophilia and Duchenne muscular dystrophy are well known X chromosome-linked conditions, which affect males more frequently as males carry a single X chromosome.

# SOURCE

LCAP (G-20) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of LCAP of human origin.

# PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200  $\mu g$  IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-247410 P, (100  $\mu$ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

# **STORAGE**

Store at 4° C, \*\*D0 NOT FREEZE\*\*. Stable for one year from the date of shipment. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.

## APPLICATIONS

LCAP (G-20) is recommended for detection of LCAP of human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000).

Suitable for use as control antibody for LCAP siRNA (h): sc-91211, LCAP shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-91211-SH and LCAP shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-91211-V.

Molecular Weight of LCAP: 17 kDa.
