METTL11B (K-17): sc-247957



BACKGROUND

METTL11B (methyltransferase-like protein 11B), also known as α N-terminal protein methyltransferase 1B, X-Pro-Lys N-terminal protein methyltransferase 1B or NTM1B, is a 283 amino acid protein that belongs to the NTM1 family and methyltransferase superfamily. The gene encoding METTL11B maps to human chromosome 1, which spans about 260 million base pairs and makes up 8% of the human genome. There are about 3,000 genes on chromosome 1, and considering the great number of genes there are also a large number of diseases associated with chromosome 1. Notably, the rare aging disease Hutchinson-Gilford progeria is associated with the LMNA gene which encodes lamin A. When defective, the LMNA gene product can build up in the nucleus and cause characteristic nuclear blebs. The mechanism of rapidly enhanced aging is unclear and is a topic of continuing exploration. The MUTYH gene is located on chromosome 1 and is partially responsible for familial adenomatous polyposis. Stickler syndrome, Parkinsons, Gaucher disease and Usher syndrome are also associated with chromosome 1.

Genetic locus: METTL11B (human) mapping to 1q24.2; Mettl11b (mouse) mapping to 1 H2.2.

SOURCE

METTL11B (K-17) is an affinity purified goat polyclonal antibody raised against a peptide mapping within an internal region of METTL11B of human origin.

PRODUCT

Each vial contains 200 μg IgG in 1.0 ml of PBS with < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.1% gelatin.

Blocking peptide available for competition studies, sc-247957 P, (100 μ g peptide in 0.5 ml PBS containing < 0.1% sodium azide and 0.2% BSA).

APPLICATIONS

METTL11B (K-17) is recommended for detection of METTL11B of mouse, rat and human origin by Western Blotting (starting dilution 1:200, dilution range 1:100-1:1000), immunofluorescence (starting dilution 1:50, dilution range 1:50-1:500) and solid phase ELISA (starting dilution 1:30, dilution range 1:30-1:3000); non cross-reactive with METTL11A.

METTL11B (K-17) is also recommended for detection of METTL11B in additional species, including equine, canine, bovine and porcine.

Suitable for use as control antibody for METTL11B siRNA (h): sc-88099, Mettl11b siRNA (m): sc-149385, METTL11B shRNA Plasmid (h): sc-88099-SH, Mettl11b shRNA Plasmid (m): sc-149385-SH, METTL11B shRNA (h) Lentiviral Particles: sc-88099-V and Mettl11b shRNA (m) Lentiviral Particles: sc-149385-V.
